

POSITION TITLE: Case Therapist

Location: St. Louis, MO (specifically St. Louis County)

Position Summary:

The Case Therapist provides assessment, treatment planning, and intensive home, school, and community based therapy services for Family Solutions for Kids clients (ages 4 to 19) and family members in their household. The person in this position also provides case management and community connections to ensure continuity of care and access to long term solutions.

Essential Job Functions:

- Provides a thorough Family Assessment and safety planning in the home, school environment or other natural environment
- Develops a Treatment Plan with measurable goals, specific to the needs of the family and updates the Plan monthly
- Provides education related to family functioning, i.e. child development, parenting skills and coaching, communication skills, self-regulation tools, assertiveness training, etc.
- Case management activities including, but not limited to, crisis planning, school advocacy, referral, linkage, and collateral contacts
- Prepares Discharge Summaries and Aftercare Plans
- Maintains required documentation and client files according to standards and as required by policy and procedure, entering information in a timely and accurate manner

Supervisory Responsibilities:

None for this position

Working Conditions:

- Works weekly in a typical office setting for meetings, trainings, supervision, etc
- Works daily in homes, schools, and community settings
- Drives an automobile on a routine basis in an urban area
- Must have the ability and energy to visit more than one family per day in order to meet productivity requirements
- Must participate in an on-call rotation with team members. Typically occurs 3 to 4 times per year, for only one week at a time
- Flexible Schedule, which require 2-3 evenings during the week to meet clients' scheduling needs. Therapist manages their schedule, and may substitute evening work for weekend hours with supervisory approval.

Job Requirements:**Education and Experience:**

Case Therapists shall possess a master's degree in Social Work, Psychology, or Counseling. Must be either licensed or provisionally licensed in a clinical discipline, i.e. LCSW, LPC, etc.

At least two (2) years of therapy experience preferred. Also prefer experience in providing in-home therapy.

Skills:

- Must be able to communicate effectively verbally, and in writing with professionals and clients
- Strong psychosocial assessment and decision making skills; possess good understanding of various treatment methodologies utilizing strength-based clinical interventions and evidence based practices
- Excellent time management, organization, planning, and assertive communication skills. Ability to prioritize tasks and resolve conflict/problem-solve with minimal supervision.
